Mark 5:24-29

What are the significant details of this hurting woman's life? She concluded her only hope was in Jesus! Where does your ultimate hope rest?

Mark 5:30-34

She touches his robe and is healed! Why does she become afraid?

She was healed of 12 years of an "unclean" outcast.

"Daughter": this is a precious woman restored to family and the spiritual community.

Mark 5:35-36

His daughter has died. Now where is his faith?

Where is your faith when something very hard and difficult happens?

Mark 5:37-43

Isaiah 55:9 Do we trust the character of God enough to trust his ways when it doesn't fit our thinking?

Those who didn't believe didn't get to see the miracle.

He is fully aware of our physical pain and suffering -AND -- He certainly empathizes with it -- but He puts a priority on our spiritual welfare and our spiritual growth to be like Christ and to be used for His kingdom.
