

BBF Children's Ministry Student Safety

Infant safety in the nursery and student safety in our children's ministry are very important to us. We have set up several policies and best practices with the twin aims of preventing child abuse and protecting the many volunteers that pour themselves into our children's ministry.

Application Process

Those working in our children and youth ministries at Bridge Bible Fellowship can expect the following in the application process:

- A background check
- An interview with a BBF Pastor or Elder
- Be required to provide three non-family references
- Sign BBF's Statement of Faith and Core Values
- Elder board approval

Nursery and Classroom Practices

In the Nursery, and each classroom, we schedule 2 to 3 children's ministry volunteers for accountability to protect both the children and the teachers.

Accountability to BBF

A member of BBF's leadership team will periodically give updates on Children's Ministries during the announcements at the Sunday morning service. They will also regularly update the BBF elder board with a current list of Children's Ministry volunteers, requesting prayer and encouragement, and inviting safety concerns involving volunteers.
