**Big Idea:** Paul answered eschatological ("end times") questions in 1 Thessalonians, and now follows up in 2 Thessalonians. The specific misinformation is that the Second Coming of Jesus Christ (the "Parousia") has already happened, and they missed it. Paul says no, you haven't missed it, because there is a sequence: the rebellion and the revealing of the man of lawlessness must come first. The identity of this man is not given, but his traits are described, e.g. he will proclaim himself to be God and deceive many.
